
## Old door for halloween,03



Here are the parts we used to make our dungeon door. All of the home centers in my area did not carry ANY styrofoam at all!!!!!!! So this is what we had to use. (Six) 12" x 36" x 1/2" sheet styrofoam and 3 wood dowels for the window.

We used hot glue to melt all six sheets together. This was the only way to connect them. they are only 1/2" thick, If you can find thicker sheets get'em. The good news is we will be able to mount this on our screen door with Velcro or some thing.

Now that all the sheets are together, we used sandpaper to make it look like wood.

My wife was very good at this so i let her go for it : ) We had a pic of an old door for a guide but, it was easier to do it free hand.

With the hot glue now dry, it adds to the over all look she did a great job!!!

Also notice the window has been cut out and the dowels, we hot glued in place on the back side of the door.
