Bat Wings How-To


Supplies and Costs



- Something to put the wings on (I'm using a 2' blucky from Oriental Trading)
- Clothes Hangers-Your closet! Black Fabric(I used an old nylon)-Cheap or free
- A bunch of pins (The kind for holding fabric in place while you sow)

Step 1

First you will need to unravel some clothes hanger. I can't really tell you how to shape the wings, but Google some bat clipart images and go with something like that.



I suggest first taking 2 clothes hangers and using one for each wing. You may want to shape them at the same time, like hold both and shape them literally at the same time.

You can do that, or make connect both ends and make a circle. Then make it rectangular and shape them separate. Whatever works for you. To connect the ends, I just used scotch tape. Sealing tape would work just as well. This is the only hard part for this prop. Take your time.

Step 2



Now that we have a shape, we need to give the wings the skin...I suppose you would call it.

Take your fabric and place it under your wings. Fold it over the metal so its tight. Now you will probably want to use a load of scotch tape for this.

Put enough tape to hold it. LOTS. Now take those pins and secure where your fabric is.

You can take off the tape now. Now do the other wing. The electrical tape border in the picture is just for show. Add it if you want to.
