The designs are all hers and I just helped her with a few ideas and a little painting and finishing.

Obviously it all starts with some foam!



Our local Home Depot didn't have the pink insulating foam that many home haunters use, so I used the foam that was available- a 10' x 4' x 2" sheet.



I gave my mom some basic ideas and then let her creativity run wild!

There's no real 'meaning' to most of the stones. We tried to avoid the usual amusing epitaphs and went more for an eclectic look.



Tarps were laid all over the deck as to avoid as much spillage as possible.



All the stones were basecoated in gray latex housepaint and allowed to dry for quite some time.
