## Mystery Fog



You can produce fog with either a tub of dry ice in warm water, or a fog machine. Fog machines are available for rent, but you have to reserve one month in advance. You could try to borrow one from a university theatrical department. Fog machines are expensive to buy, costing from \$200 up to \$5,000. There is also a product that is smoke effect in an aerosol can that lasts up to 5 minutes which sells for \$15-\$20.

In the fog, who knows what might come out of the bushes. Also, play with strobe or UV lighting for added effect, but be careful not to disorient little ghosts and witches right off the porch steps. From an open window, use a squirt gun through the fog on the unsuspecting treaters. You can also use canned spray string.
