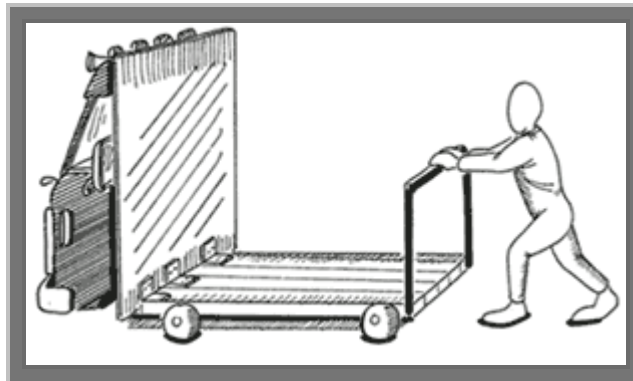

## On-Coming Traffic



If you have a hallway connecting to the front entryway, leave all the interior lights off. When the doorbell rings, slowly open the door with a black thread, then flip on a bright spotlight shining right at the kids.

Now, start the sound effect of a motor cycle starting up, then accelerating to a rapid speed. Jerk the light up slightly at this point, like the front end of a motor cycle would jump, then begin running toward the door with the light shining at the kids. Practice first for improved realism.

There are many other variations to this trick, such as a train, a jet landing, or a space ship. Do whatever it takes to develop good sound effects, or buy prerecorded sound tapes or CDs. You can also make the front end of a bus, truck, or car. Attach it to a four wheel cart, and roll it at the front door for the same effect, only in this case use a faint flashlight, so the kids can see what's coming at them.
